We hope you are excited and looking forward to having fun on this trip or event! It should definitely be a lot of fun and a great opportunity for each of you. In order to make this event successful everyone needs to act responsibly and follow the rules and guidelines outlined in this document. Your cooperation on these items will help make this a great, enjoyable event for everyone involved.

General

- This is a TFMS sponsored event and all rules and guidelines outlined in the Student Handbook remain in effect. This includes behavior, dress code and discipline.
- Respect the people, equipment, accommodations, students and authority involved in the trip.
- Be prompt and on time for all events and required activities. (Prompt means 5 minutes early!)
- Follow all instructions from Mr. Wenman AND the Chaperones.
- Have a Buddy with you at all times.

Concert Uniforms

Remember to bring all the clothes you need for the performance. How the band/choir looks and presents itself is part of performing as an ensemble. You are up on a stage and items like white socks, bare legs, etc are very noticeable.

Refer to the appropriate band or choir survival guide for this year to determine acceptable concert dress.

Chaperones

- Chaperones are responsible for students and you must follow their instruction as if Mr. Wenman made the request.
- Please go to a chaperone first for all questions and issues.
- Make sure a chaperone knows where you are at all times.
- The chaperones will report to Mr. Wenman as required.

Bus/Motor Coach Guidelines

- The primary responsibility of your drivers is to transport you safely. Please treat the motor coaches and drivers with respect.
- Food and beverages are not permitted on the coach.
- Personal music devices with headphones are permitted. i.e. iPods (Student is responsible for the safety of these devices.)
- Please maintain a clean coach and use the garbage bags available on the coach.
- For the safety of all, no one should be standing while the motor coach is in motion.
- Students should always remain seated until asked to get off the coach. Wait for any instructions before leaving the coach.

Spending Money

While spending money will vary considerably from student to student, the following may serve as guidelines.

- Meals – allow approximately \$6 - \$10 per meal.
- Souvenirs – T-shirts and sweatshirts seem to be the most popular souvenirs and can range from \$5 to \$25 or more depending on location.
