All concerts are scheduled to begin at 7pm. Mr. Wenman requires all choir students to be in the choir room by 6:30pm for setup and warm-up. Most parents stay after they drop their children off and wait for the concert to begin. This 30 minute window is usually when we sell the majority of our items. We sell the remaining items (usually sell out) after the concert, mostly to the performing students. Baked goods may be dropped off at the office earlier in the day, marked "choir concert", or bring that evening.

Bake Sale Items –

- Items can be homemade or purchased
 - Price items at \$1 each, including bottled water. Ask for those who are donating items, to cut and wrap them into \$1 serving sizes. We purposely do not sell coffee, or soda, to keep the spills to a minimum.
- Suggestions;
- Brownies – thin 4x4" squares or thick 2x2" squares
 - Cookies – 1 huge gourmet 4" or 3-2" cookies
 - Cupcakes – 1
- Water bottles for the bake sale are available in the band room. It would be nice if you were able to have them in coolers, but not necessary.
